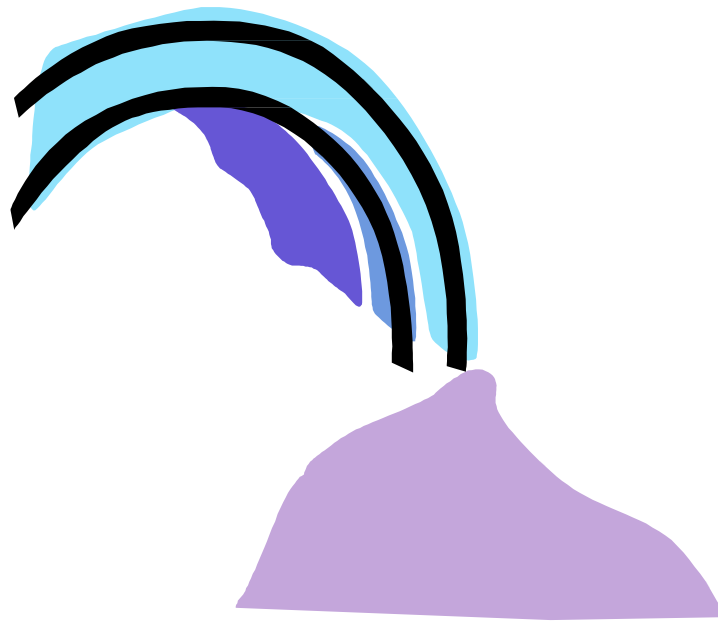


Your CT Scan
