




Your information, your rights. Help us to help you!



Norfolk and Norwich University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust will ask for and keep information about you, so that you can receive proper care and treatment when you need it, for as long as you need it.

The law regulating your personal information has changed. It strengthens your rights over your personal information and allows us to collect, use and share your

information for the provision of care. If we need to share information that identifies you, for any other purposes, we will seek your consent.



Your Rights under the Data Protection Act 2018

To tell you why we collect your information, how and who uses it

To provide you with a copy of this information

To request any changes to inaccurate or incomplete information

To delete or remove your information when we no longer need it

To restrict the use of your information

To object to how we use your information

To ask us to copy or transfer your information to another service provider in a safe and secure way

To object to any decision made without human involvement (eg. By a computer or system)
