What is the Cromer Acute Oncology & Haematology Service (AOHS)?

Our service has been developed to help patients who have symptoms or side effects from their cancer/ treatments, to be cared for closer to home. We work as a satellite service to the Norwich AOHS (you will have been given a yellow and red card alert card).

Who is the AOHS Cromer team?

We are a nurse led service with two Advanced Nurse Practitioners, a Nurse Specialist and an Assistant Practitioner.

Where will patients be assessed?

We are situated within the North Norfolk Macmillan centre. We advise all patients to kindly telephone our service to discuss symptoms and concerns.

Depending on your symptoms you may be advised to attend the Acute Oncology Service at the Norfolk and Norwich University Hospital

How we can help:

- Telephone and face to face assessments and diagnosis of complications of your cancer or cancer treatment

- Procedures including blood tests, central line flushes and dressings. Care of catheters, drains and stomas.
- Treatments including fluid replacement and antibiotics. Symptom management for pain, nausea, constipation, diarrhoea, breathlessness, skin rashes and other concerns
- Information, advice and support including Referrals to community support teams
- Liaising with your specialist team and providing specialist advice as needed
