

Your doctor feels you can arrange a follow up appointment, when you need it, using a new booking system.



Your doctor has told you what changes to look for in your condition. If you have these changes you should book your own follow up appointment.



If you need an appointment, you should book this before <<DATE>>.

After this date you will need to contact your GP before you can have a hospital appointment.

How do I book a follow up appointment?
