

Things to consider

- Please remove all jewellery prior to surgery.
- You will be advised not to drive home following the surgery, please arrange appropriate transport.
- You can eat and drink as normal.
- Continue to take regular medication unless you have been instructed otherwise.
- Please wear loose clothing to your appointment.
- Before the day of surgery please purchase your own pain relief.
- We provide soft drinks, tea, coffee and biscuits following your surgery.
- Please bear in mind the waiting area is shared with other departments.
- You will be assessed and admitted per clinical priority, you may want to bring a book or an electronic tablet.
